

SCORING SYSTEM



MSRC RESEARCH AWARDS

Research excellence plays a pivotal role in advancing scientific knowledge and improving healthcare outcomes. To recognize and reward outstanding contributions in research, this scoring system has been established to ensure a fair, transparent, and objective evaluation process for the MSRC Awards.

- **Best Researcher Award (Students Track):**

- Q1 Publication = 3 points.
- Q2 Publication = 2 points.
- Q3 Publication = 1 point.
- Q4 Publication = 0.5 points.
- First/Corresponding Author: +1 point per publication.

- **Research Productivity Award:**

- Each published article = 1 point (regardless of quartile ranking).
- Each accepted conference abstract = 0.5 points.

- **Best Research Presentation Award (Based on Competition Results):**

- 1st Place = 3 points.
- 2nd Place = 2 points.
- 3rd Place = 1 point.
- Participation = 0.5 points.

- **Best Researcher Award (Intern/Resident/Master's & PhD Candidates Track):**

- Each published article = 1 point (regardless of quartile ranking).
- Each Q1 Publication = +1 point per publication.
- First/Corresponding Author: +1 point per publication.
- Each accepted conference abstract = 0.5 points.

- **Tiebreakers:**

- Higher number of Q1 publications.
- Higher number of first-author publications.
- More conference presentations.

- **Eligibility Requirements:**

- Publications must be peer-reviewed and indexed in Scopus/Web of Science/PubMed.
- Only research completed during the specified timeframe is considered.
- Proof of authorship (e.g., DOI, journal link) is required for verification.
